

Our union achieved a <u>major victory</u> late last year when the Biden administration announced a new temporary waiver process for the Public Service Loan Forgiveness program. This PSLF waiver can give you credit toward loan forgiveness for past federal student loan payments, even if those payments didn't count before. That's exciting news that could help you and hundreds of thousands of other borrowers finally get your federal loans forgiven.

In Minnesota, members have already seen more than \$1 million in student loan debt discharged.

- automatic annual union membership
- loss of membership (Wisconsin lost over half their membership)
