

#### Meet our new SEED Co-coordinator, Beth Lynn Heimerl

A huge thanks goes out to the AHEM Union for helping keep our SEED (Seeking Educational Equity and Diversity) program alive here in Anoka-Hennepin! I'm Beth Lynn Heimerl, middle level educator at OVMS who has taught in many, many subject areas over the past 28 years. One thing I have found is that no matter the curriculum, building relationships with your students must precede learning! I have been a SEED participant and now facilitator for over 20 years. Each journey brings new insight into my students' experiences and challenges my own hidden biases . I am honored to be working as one of the co-coordinators of this transformative work centered around Diversity, Equity and Inclusion. We still have a
