Pension Updates



The election results are in and Minnesota voted for public education! Talking points, info about decision-makers and more are coming in the weeks ahead.

Moving to Phase II

This edition contains level-setting information to help members with names of plans, definitions, formulas and other necessary information when advocating for strong pensions in Minnesota.

Our educator plans in Minnesota

<u>PERA or Public Employees Retirement Association</u> is a set of five defined-benefit pension plans. Non-licensed employees of public-school districts fall under the <u>General</u> **Plan**.

TRA or Teachers Retirement Association is a defined-benefit pension plan for Minnesota public education teachers (not including St. Paul).

<u>SPTRFA or St. Paul Teachers' Retirement Fund Association</u> is a defined-benefit pension plan for anyone employed in a St. Paul Public schools' position which requires a teacher's license.

Emerging Leaders Pilot Program

Interested in developing your leadership skills within the scope of your union? This program, Emerging Leaders, is available to ANY member, regardless of leadership experience, to participate in a pilot program of Emerging Leaders. This program has three parts: Leadership of Self, Leading of Others, and Leading the Organization, and works to empower union members to develop their leadership skills, abilities, and philosophies.

The first part of the program, titled <u>"Leading of Self"</u>, will be piloted on Saturday, November 19, 9 am - 3 pm.

<u>"Leading of Others"</u> Saturday, December 10, 9 am - 3 pm

<u>"Leading the Organization"</u> Saturday, January 14, 9 am - 3 pm

Education Minnesota will cover round-trip milage, and we have limited number of hotel rooms available (register ASAP). We are hoping that registrants can commit to all three parts of the pilot. However, if this is a barrier, members can participate in one or two sessions.




