Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Anoka-Hennepin Independent School District #11

and

Anoka Hennepin Education Minnesota

WHEREAS, the parties are in negotiations for a new collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the parties have mutual interest in recognizing professional responsibility as well as professional time performed beyond the duty day; and

WHEREAS, the Union has proposed teacher professional discretion and judgment with the respect working on site or remotely on grading days at the end of each trimester;

NOW THEREFORE, for the July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023 contract, only, the parties agree to the following:

- Teachers may use their professional judgment and discretion to work on site or remotely for the District designated grading days at the end of trimesters with appropriate notification/communication to the principal or program supervisor.
- Teachers must be available via phone and email and must not use a personal day
 or seniority day the day before or the day after in order to work remotely.
- District required work must be completed by the deadline established by each site.
 Each teacher must follow any checkout procedure with the principal or program supervisor prior to leaving at the end of the school year.

Government Relations Report

Voting and Election Results:

Thank you! Minnesota turned out nearly the highest voter turnout in the nation, about 60.4%, second only to Maine (60.9%). Wisconsin is just behind us, as usual. All the help we got from educators, especially our building reps and WALS, is appreciated. Turnout is how education wins.

As most of you now know, Democrats continue to hold all the statewide offices, retained the MN House, and flipped the MN Senate. It's go time for education.

Lobbying:

In the next month or so, we will be making our targeted list of legislators and setting our lobbying priorities. The 93rd session of the MN Legislature will start January 3rd.

MN Legislature Committee Chairs have been set for the upcoming MN Legislative session. Melissa Hortman will remain the House Speaker. Our local Zach Stephenson will chair Commerce Finance and Policy. For Education Finance: Rep. Cheryl Youakim, and Education Policy: Rep. Laurie Pryor. In the Senate, the majority leader will be Kari Dziedzic, John Hoffman will remain the Human Services chair. The Education Finance Committee Chair: Sen. Mary Kunesh and Education Policy Committee Chair: Sen. Steve Cwodzinski.

Pension Updates



Education Minnesota has long advocated for the best pension plans for its members. That work continues with our *2022-23 Pension Advocacy Plan*.

Last Spring, more than 3,600 members contacted their legislators and the governor supporting improvements and specific pension bills in the 2022 Legislature. From that work, as well as the work from our 2022 Pension Task Force, our new advocacy gives us the opportunity to persuade lawmakers across the state to commit to making educator pensions a priority.
