Government Relations

MN Legislature:

Governor Walz and Democratic leadership announced a budget agreement last week, including a \$2.2 billion increase for state schools. This represents overall about \$275 per pupil to the basic funding formula. Also, in the agreement is \$3 billion for tax relief, \$2.3 billion for an all-cash infrastructure bill, \$1 billion for housing, and nearly \$670 million for a statewide paid family and medical leave program. This represents a significant state budget increase.

Thanks to Emilie Buesing for sharing this <u>Legislature Tracker</u> that shows where we are as a state on many different bills.

Pensions:

The governor and legislative leaders also set a budget of \$600million for reforming the state's public pension system, which on its own is far too low to fund what is being asked for. It appears that it would take over 2 billion to fix the system.


